Membership Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members and have been established to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the Club's facilities. Parents have the obligation to review these rules and regulations with their children and to teach them to obey instructions given to them by the Club's management, life guards and any other authorized representatives. The Club's management is authorized to enforce these rules and regulations, failure to do so will cause you to forfeit your membership and any dues associated with your membership.

Article I. Grounds

1. All members and their guests must keep the Club's property clean and free from litter.
2. All areas of the Club's property shall be free from smoking and/or tobacco products except for the parking lot.
3. No animals or pets shall be permitted upon the Club's property.
4. The tennis, basketball, and volleyball courts are solely for the use for which they were intended. No roller skates, skateboards, bicycles, or vehicles of any kind are permitted on the courts.

Article II. Swimming Pool

1. The Club's management has the right to set the hours of operation. Generally the pool will be open **Daily from 11:00 am to 8:00 pm, Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend**. This time frame may change due to inclement weather, when temperatures are below 75 degrees, or if there is fewer than 25 people at the club.
2. The Club's management has the right to close to pool for special events or unforeseen maintenance during regular hours. Management will do it's best to give advance notice to the membership in such a case. There are no refunds/credits for closures by management.
3. Safety breaks of 15 minutes every hour will be enforced by the life guards. The breaks will commence during the last 15 minutes of every hour. Only adults 18 years of age and older may swim during safety breaks. Children 3 years old and younger, accompanied by a parent, may also swim during safety breaks.
4. Children from 18 to 6 years old may have full swimming privileges without regard to being accompanied by an adult member, if the child has passed a swimming test to the satisfaction of the Club's management and if the child's parent or guardian has consented in writing to the child using the pool unaccompanied by an adult member.
5. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult.
6. Use of the Kiddie pool shall be limited to children 5 years of age and under. These children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
7. All swimmers must be clean before entering the pool. Showers are provided and should be used prior to entering the pool. **Please do not use the pool if you have had diarrhea in the last two weeks.**
8. Do not distract the lifeguards from their duties. No conversations should be held with the lifeguards while on duty.
9. Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed or red eyes, infections, or to anyone wearing bandages.
10. No running, pushing, wrestling, ball-playing or undue disturbances shall be permitted within the fenced pool area or clubhouse.
11. Air-inflated tubes, life-jackets, masks, toys, goggles, flippers and any other pool accessories may be allowed at the discretion of the Club's management.
12. Children who are not toilet trained shall wear a swim diaper.
13. No diving shall be allowed except off of the diving boards.
14. Flotation devices are not permitted in the diving board area.
15. No swimmers will be allowed in the diving area. Adults or guardian are not permitted to catch a child diving off the diving board.
16. Only one person will be allowed on the slide at a time, this includes the ladder for the slide.

Article III. Tennis, Basketball, and Corn Hole Courts.

1. Play and reservations are limited to 1 hour for each singles group and 2 hours for each doubles group when other members are waiting. Reserved court time has priority over walk-ons. Court time may be reserved by calling the Dolphin.
2. Players who have left the court because of the 1 hour time limitation for singles and 2 hour limitations for doubles may re-register for play and wait their turn for another court opening.
3. Playing time is unlimited when all courts are not in use.
4. The courts will not be available outside of pool hours unless prior arrangements are made with the Club's management.
5. Non-players are prohibited from remaining inside the enclosed tennis court during play.
6. Leaning, striking the top of, or jumping over the tennis net is strictly prohibited.
7. Hanging on the rim of the basketball hoop is strictly prohibited.

Article IV. Rules of Conduct

1. Drive slowly and carefully, and park only in designated areas.
2. Alcohol, beer or other intoxicating beverages shall neither be brought nor consumed on the Club premises.
3. Only authorized personnel are permitted in the purifying, storage or concession rooms.
4. All members shall give full consideration in regards to rights and privileges of others.
5. No glass containers of any kind are permitted within the fenced pool area or upon the court surfaces.
6. All commonly recognized or posted rules of safety, conduct, and sanitation shall be observed.
7. All accidents shall be immediately reported to the Club's management.
8. Trespassing upon the Club's property by a non-member or by anyone during the time of day in which the grounds are closed is a criminal action and will be prosecuted.

Article V. Guests

1. Conduct of guests shall be the sole responsibility of the sponsoring member. Guests include anyone other than a member.
2. All guests must be accompanied by a Club member. All guests shall be registered at the concession stand and pay the guest fee prior to entering the facility.
3. Daily guest fees shall be determined solely by the Club's management.
4. Guests shall be limited to 10 visits with a member. The guest will be required to purchase an individual membership if more than 10 visits.
5. Special guest groups, such as baseball teams, church groups, classmates etc. may enter if accompanied by a member and upon payment of the regular guest fee. Any groups of 3 or more guests must be registered with the Club's management 3 days prior to the date of admission.
6. Babysitters for members' children shall be exempt from the 10 visit limitation, but must pay the regular daily guest fee.

Article VI. Discipline

1. Failure to comply with any of the above rules and regulations may result in the suspension of privileges for that member, or dismissal from the premises of any guest. If the infraction of the rules is deemed serious by the sole discretion of the Club's management the member may be terminated, forfeiting any dues paid.
2. All complaints must be registered in writing to the Club's management and mailed to The Dolphin Club of Troy, Inc. P.O. Box 344, Troy, Ohio 45373
3. The Club's management and the lifeguards are the final authority on all matters of discipline at the Club. Their instructions must be followed or disciplinary action in the form of suspension of privileges may result.

Article VII. Miscellaneous

1. The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage of members' personal property including vehicles on premises.
2. These rules and regulations may be amended or changed by the sole discretion of the Club's management.
3. The Club is not responsible for personal injury, accident or loss, but will make every effort to maintain the highest degree of safety and care at the Club's facilities.

These rules and regulations are satisfactory and will be complied with by all members of my family and guests. By signing the accompanying application you agree that your family will abide by these rules and you understand that failure to do so may cause you to forfeit your membership and any dues associated with your membership. Membership to the Dolphin Club of Troy is a privilege, not a right.
